Candidate must be an Ontario Certified Teacher (OCT) and possess B. Ed. The appropriate candidate should have a demonstrated history of proven success. This candidate will work in cooperation with school administration to ensure the school's mission and vision are effectively implemented and the school meets changing student need and consistently exceeds all stakeholder expectations. - Provide appropriate feedback on student work.
- Encourage and monitor the progress of individual students.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of students' progress and development.
- Update all necessary records accurately and completely as required.
- Prepare required written reports on students and activities.
- Appropriately manage student behavior in the classroom by establishing and enforcing rules and routines.
- Participate in extracurricular activities such as social activities, sporting activities, clubs and student organizations.
- Participate in school meetings and parent meetings.
- Effectively communicate necessary information regularly to students, colleagues and parents regarding student progress and student needs in written and verbal communications.
- Keep up to date with developments in subject area, teaching resources and methods and make relevant changes to instructional plans and activities.
- Work closely with school leaders to analyze student assessment data and use data to inform instruction.
- Collaborate in and with various teams to discuss student work, share best practices, and ensure student mastery of standards
- Participate in on-going professional development in the spirit of continuous improvement
